

The Make Jesus Known Training is a 4-week series on evangelism that will push your group or community out of their comfort zone. We want to challenge everyone to make evangelism a lifestyle and see Jesus work in you and through you. We believe this month will be transformational.

OBJECTIVES OF THIS SERIES

- This training is meant to be a catalyst for a movement of evangelism.
- · Break down the fears and misinformation surrounding evangelism.
- Increase the amount of prayer in your group.
- A focus on relational evangelism.
- · Break down what it means to love your neighbor.
- · A refreshed outlook to trust in the Holy Spirit.
- Learn the skill to start spiritual conversations.
- A focus on sharing the Gospel biblically and practically.

HOW TO STRUCTURE YOUR 4 WEEKLY GATHERINGS

- Part I: Welcome + Student Testimony (5 minutes)
- Part II: Pulse Video (8-12 Minutes)
- Part III: Ministry Leader Teaching (10-20 Minutes)
- Part IV: Small Group Discussion (20-45 Minutes)





PART I: STUDENT TESTIMONY

Each week, plan to have a young person share about a time they have personally shared their faith with their family, friends, on social media, or even with a stranger, regardless of the outcome. It is one thing to hear stories from you as the leader, but it becomes a whole other level when they can hear stories from their peers!

Consider continuing these weekly student testimonies even after the series is over.

PART II: PULSE VIDEOS

Each video was created to be included in your normal ministry context. If you meet on Wednesday nights, show these videos and use this content on Wednesday nights. If you meet with your students or young adults on Sundays, use that normal time when they are already there.

PART III: MINISTRY LEADER TEACHING

You know your group. That's why we've saved key evangelism principles for you to teach and preach after you show the video. Use the leader guide to shape your lesson, but be sure to use both the video and the written content each week. They are designed to work together.

PART IV: SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION

Small group questions allow your group to interact with the content. Many students learn best when they can process out loud. The included small group questions are a starting point, but you'll want to add your own ice-breakers and follow-up questions. You're the expert at what engages your group.

WEEK 5

We believe that you may also want or need a fifth week to have your community come back and share their evangelism experiences with each other. You can have an open mic time or reach out to your group and invite a few of them to share. At the least, include some questions during your small group time to help them process and to encourage them to keep going!
